They established a Technical group for joint actions related to COVID-19





Background

The impact of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) pandemic on global air transport is without precedent. Airports have seen a -28.4 per cent decline in global passenger traffic volumes for the first guarter of 2020, equivalent to a reduction of 612 million passengers in absolute terms. These volumes (domestic and https://www.icao.int/covid/cart/Pages/Aircraft-Module.aspx and traffic) are expected to decrease by -50.4 per cent for 2020 as a whole as compared to 2019




Pharma - unprecedent challenges for the logistics




